For the last three decades, the **Small Miracles Golf Tournament** has made a difference in the lives of infants and families served by Einstein, funding *more than \$7 million* in comprehensive medical, social, and community services. While in an Einstein neonatal intensive care unit (NICU), babies are cared for by our team of experts.

This year, funds raised by Small Miracles will help purchase two bilirubin monitors for use in outpatient practices at Trappe Pediatrics and Montgomery Family Practice. These monitors will allow the practices to monitor the bilirubin level of babies and prevent the need to return to the hospital for testing. At Einstein Medical Center Philadelphia, in addition to a jet ventilator for the NICU, Small Miracles will support funding for a shuttle that will allow us to transport very low birth weight babies to the NICU. The shuttle also serves as the bassinet for the babies in the NICU, thus decreasing their handling as they are very fragile. At Einstein Medical Center Montgomery, Small Miracles will help purchase a neonatal transporter to provide safe transport of neonates from the delivery room or the Emergency Department to the NICU.
