Career Fair and Vendor Expo, Part of Postdoctoral Research Symposium

The 2nd Annual Postdoctoral Research Symposium was held on June 19th, 2007, hosted by the JCGS Office of Postdoctoral Affairs and the Jefferson Postdoctoral Association. Although research presentations were limited to postdoctoral fellows, Master of Science and PhD students were welcomed to the posters, presentations, reception, and especially the career and vendor fair.

Twenty-eight postdoctoral fellows gave oral presentations and 27 gave poster presentations compared to 10 oral presentations and 36 poster presentations last year.

Eight winners received cash prizes toward professional expenses.

The keynote address by Dr. Kenneth Fischbeck, "Hereditary Motor Neuron Diseases", was well attended.

The day-long event

concluded with a martini reception.

Several Jefferson alumni came back to campus as representatives and recruiters for their organizations. They included Peter Jackman, MS, JD (MS-Microbiology), patent lawyer at Sterne, Kessler, Goldstein, and Fox, Marc Abrams, PhD (PhD- Biochemistry and Molecular Biology) and Philip McKenna, PhD (PhD- Microbiology and Molecular Virology), both are research scientists at Merck, and John Ellis, PhD, (PhD-Biochemistry), Executive Director of the PA Society for Biomedical Research. Johnson & Johnson, the American Association for Cancer Research, and AAAS Science and Policy Fellowships had representatives on hand to accept resumes for a wide range of positions and fellowships. 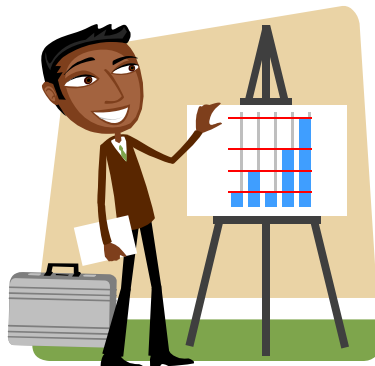

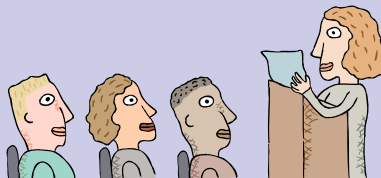
