

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS: BACHELOR OF SCIENCE

Students with 0-15 credits

Students with fewer than 15 credits are not eligible for admission to the program. Students must transfer at least 15 credits from another accredited institution of higher education or complete at least 15 credits at Jefferson as a non-matriculated student prior to entry into the program.

Students with 15-60 credits (Degree Completion)

Students transferring 15-60 applicable college credits from Thomas Jefferson University or other accredited institutions of higher education are eligible for admission to the BS program. These students should

- Complete pre-admission interview/advising session with academic advisor (for advising appointment, call 215-503-8414)
- Submit an official copy of college/university transcripts
- Demonstrate an approximate GPA of 3.0 on transferred credits
- Provide documentation of current licensure or certification for BS-HPM.
- Complete Application Form and submit application fee.

Notes:

- Students may transfer up to 60 *applicable* credits from other accredited institutions of higher education. "Applicable" credits are those credits earned in courses that directly satisfy specific requirements of the BS-HSM/HPM/HSMIS degree.
- A maximum of 15 of the 60 credits may be earned by examination (i.e., College Level Examination Program [CLEP] or Challenge Examinations.)
- Students who have acquired knowledge through prior experience may apply for credit through portfolio assessment, a rigorous process of self-assessment and critical evaluation of work documentation by qualified reviewers.
