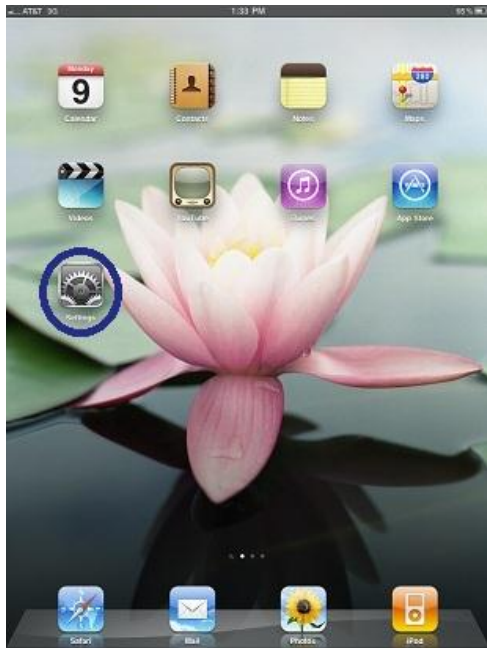


iConfiguring the iPad for the Jefferson Student Wireless network.

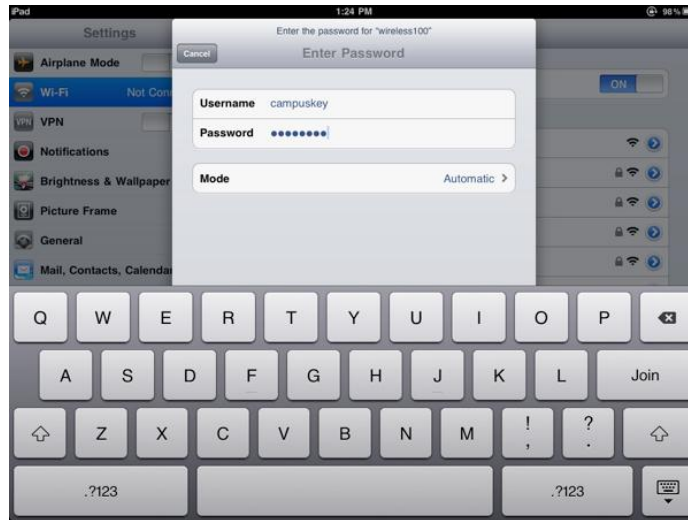
1. Select the “Settings” panel icon on the desktop.



2. Then select the Wi-Fi option on the left hand column. You will see a list of available networks to connect to on campus. You want to select “wireless100” to connect to. Your campus key will not authenticate on the other networks.



3. Enter your campus key and password. Leave the mode at automatic. Click the Join button.



4. Accept the Security Certificates. You will get one of two certificates radius5 or radius6. The next time you connect at a different location or time you may have to accept the other radius certificate just click the accept button.



5. Open your Safari web browser and connect to any non-jefferson website. (yahoo.com, google.com and any other site.) Your web browser will be redirected to the Student Asset Registration Page. Here you will register you device on the network.



6. Click the accept button.


Jefferson Student Network Device Registration

Please login using your Campus Key and Password to initiate the registration process.



7. Add your campus key and password and register.



8. You should then see the “Registration is now complete” page.



9. Go back to the Settings panel and select the Wi-Fi option on the left column. Turn off the Wi-Fi with the slider in the top right hand column. Leave it off for a couple minutes. Then turn the Wi-Fi back on and you should be connected back to the wireless100 network.



Just remember that twice a year all student devices are removed from the Student Asset Registration Database. On or after Dec31st and June 30th you will need to register all your personal devices on the Jefferson Student wireless network.
