Dixon, Thomas Jefferson University College of Nursing's Abington-Dixon campus will be relocated to Horsham, PA and be known as the Dixon Campus in time for the fall 2020 semester. Selected to provide state-of-the-art nursing educational facilities and resources for students in the region, the new location – 300 Lakeside Drive – is one mile from the current campus and will give the program the capacity to double its enrollment over the next five years.
