

## Career Outcome Rates: Classes of 2017 & 2018

---

**Career outcome rate** is defined as the percentage of graduates who are identified as working full or part time, placed in a residency or fellowship, accepted a job, or continuing education. This is calculated by the following equation:

$$\frac{\textit{Working Full or Part Time} + \textit{Residency or Fellowship} + \textit{Accepted a Job} + \textit{Continuing Education}}{\textit{All Students} - \textit{Not Seeking Placement} - \textit{Unknown}}$$

Utilizing the following data sources increased the knowledge rate of graduates' career outcomes:

- Post-Graduation Survey
- Phone call outreach from the Career Development Center
- Exit Satisfaction Survey
- Faculty knowledge
- Social media (e.g., LinkedIn, employer website, etc.)
