 $\frac{\textit{Working Full or Part Time} + \textit{Residency or Fellowship} + \textit{Accepted a Job} + \textit{Continuing Education}}{\textit{All Students} - \textit{Not Seeking Placement} - \textit{Unknown}}$
