

 - Application fee \$60, waived for Jefferson employees/alumni
- Transcripts from all colleges/universities attended
- 2 Letters of Recommendation (academic or professional)
- Personal Statement with professional goals
- Resume/CV
- Current, unencumbered RN license

Admissions Timeline

- Applications are accepted starting approximately 1 year prior to the term start
- Completed applications are reviewed on a rolling basis until the deadline, with decisions rendered in about 3 weeks
- Available Start Term: Summer (mid-May)
- Final Application Deadline: see website for deadline
