Call For proposals Smart and Healthy Cities - NOW OPEN! ERASMUS+ KA171

August 15, 2023

Thomas Jefferson University in partnership with Università Iuav di Venezia, Italy, has been the recipient of an Erasmus+ for Higher Education grant funded by the European Union Program (ERASMUS+ KA 171). The grant supports student mobility for training and education, as well as staff mobility for training and teaching between the Institute for Smart and Healthy Cities at Thomas Jefferson University and Università Iuav di Venezia.

The Application deadline is Oct 31, 2023 for the academic Year 2024/25.

All activities must be completed by July 31, 2025.

Under this program, the following opportunities are available for Jefferson students and staff at Università Iuav di Venezia, Venice:

1. Student mobility

The Erasmus+ program targets students in good standing. The selected students will participate in learning activities and attend research seminars and/or courses.

Mobility for studies/research

7 students (3 months) – Level: students in one of the following programs:

- a. Master's degree in Architecture, Urban Planning, Regional Planning, Engineering, Public Health, Population Health
- b. PhD in Population Health, Architecture, Engineering

As per the Erasmus+ guidelines, the amount of the mobility grant includes a contribution for travel (1 round-trip ticket per beneficiary) and a monthly scholarship covering meals/accommodation as follows:
