What makes a successful Health Mentor?

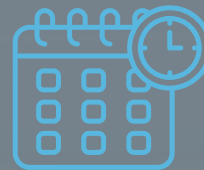
- ✓ Completes all three meetings with their team over a span of one and a half years, and shares their life and healthcare journey with students.
- ✓ Recognizes their student team members are not yet licensed professionals and thus cannot provide healthcare.
- ✓ Communicates with students only through official Health Mentors Program channels.
- ✓ Respects students' privacy and time, and does not connect with them on personal social media platforms (e.g., Facebook, X, Instagram, LinkedIn).

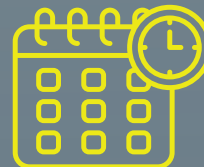
WHEN DO I MEET WITH MY TEAM?

Meeting #1



Occurs fall semester of the students' first year. The Health Mentor selects one of four pre-set dates and chooses whether the meeting will be held in person at TJU's Center City Campus or Virtually.

Meeting #2



Occurs spring semester of the students' first year at a time and location determined by the Health Mentor (Mentor's Home, TJU's Center City Campus, or Virtually).

Meeting #3



Occurs fall semester of the students' second year at a time and location determined by the Health Mentor (Mentor's Home, TJU's Center City Campus, or Virtually).

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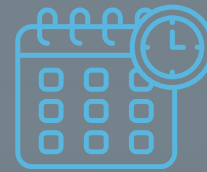
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What makes a successful student team member?

- ✓ Wears professional attire and a name badge when meeting the Health Mentor, in person or virtually.
- ✓ Refers the Health Mentor to healthcare professionals for diagnosis or care inquiries.
- ✓ Emails HMP@jefferson.edu or attends scheduled office hours for any concerns about working with the Health Mentor and/or team.
- ✓ Checks the meeting time, place, and details with the Health Mentor before every visit.
- ✓ Keeps Health Mentor's information confidential and does not use Health Mentors' names in assignments.
- ✓ Respects the Health Mentor's privacy and time and recognizes that they are a volunteer teacher and not a patient.

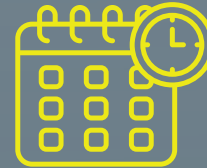
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
