Notes:

Students must meet progression criteria to be eligible to interview for the graduate-level Pharmacy program in Center City as follows:

- No less than "C" grade in any course (including labs)
- Preferred 3.0 GPA in program's math/science prerequisite courses

- Minimum 72 credits required by end of second year to matriculate into graduate Pharmacy program.
- In addition to GPA requirements, students must apply to Pharmacy program through PharmCAS after July Year 1, and interview early fall of Year 2. Students who do not meet criteria and/or are not accepted into PharmD program must change major to earn BS at the East Falls campus.
