

Learn the recipe for a strong 3MT | 3MT Training Workshop | 2021

Instructions for the Online Video Module:

Please remember to email <u>gsa@jefferson.edu</u> <u>your campus key</u> to be added to the Canvas 3MT Group. You will not be able to access the 3MT page on Canvas until you are registered as a student.

- 1. Go to <u>canvas.jefferson.edu</u>
- 2. Log into Canvas using your campus key and password
- 3. Click on the '3MT Group' course (under 'Courses' on the left side of your screen)
- 4. Go to 'Discussions' and load the example video links *before* viewing the online training video.
- 5. Go to 'Files' and double-click the '3MT Training Materials' folder. This folder contains the training worksheet, online training video, and instructions on how to access Canvas.
- 6. Be sure to load 3MT example videos *before* viewing during the training module.
- 7. Watch the online training module provided in the '3MT Group' on Canvas
 - a. While watching the video, make sure to watch the 3MT example videos and complete the exercises. This will greatly help you form your talk.
 - b. Don't forget to use your resources!
