Standardized tests such as AP, IB and CLEP will be accepted if the credit appears on an official transcript.

Course Clarification: All science courses must be completed within **5 years** of application to Jefferson. Exceptions to the 5 year rule include continuous enrollment that exceeds 5 years and/or continuous work experience since graduation in a laboratory/science setting. Courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or above to meet the prerequisite requirement. A grade of "C-"or below will not meet the prerequisite requirement. Credits are calculated on a semester scale; if courses are taken on a quarter scale, the credit hours will be converted to the semester credit scale.
