The Short Form can be scored with missing values using the following process: 1.) calculate the mean score for the completed items; 2.) use the mean score value for the missing item(s) value; 3.) convert the raw score by using the conversion table as you would normally do. NOTE: if more that 50% of the items are missing, the score cannot be estimated.
