

What do we do?

The Jefferson Autism Center of Excellence (JeffACE) works to help people with autism by doing important research, teaching others, helping communities, and creating programs that make a difference around the world.

What is Occupational Therapy?

Occupational Therapy (OT) helps children develop the skills they need for everyday activities - or 'occupations' - like playing, learning, getting dressed, and interacting with others.

Why Might a Child Need OT?

Children may benefit from OT if they need help with: - Fine motor skills - holding a pencil, using scissors, buttoning clothes - Gross motor skills - balance, coordination, strength - Sensory processing - reacting to sounds, textures, or movement in helpful ways - Self-care - dressing, feeding, brushing teeth - Emotional

regulation - managing big feelings and staying calm - Attention and focus - staying on task at home or school

What Does an Occupational Therapist Do?

OTs work with children through fun, play-based activities to build important skills. They also support families and teachers with strategies that help kids succeed at home and school.

In Simple Terms:

Occupational Therapy helps your child gain independence, build confidence, and do the things they need and want to do every day.
