Homelessness Prevention Program

Catholic Social Services provides safe shelter and a warm bed for thousands of men, women, and children. Through CSS we help families in our communities get rent and mortgage utility assistance.

Sites:

- St John's Hospice is a drug and alcohol-free emergency shelter/residence for men who are in transition from homelessness to independent living in the community.
- The Good Shepherd Program of St. John's Hospice provides residential services for medically fragile men experiencing homelessness. This program provides the opportunity for men to stabilize their medical condition and develop plans for a permanent housing arrangement.
- Mercy Hospice of Catholic Social Services is a residential program for women in recovery.
- Saint Mary's Residence provides a safe and affordable home where seniors share life with other seniors on a daily basis.
- Women of Hope-Lombard Street is a Safe Haven program serving young single women experiencing homelessness.
