Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing

The Office of Supportive Housing's (OSH) prevention services include housing stabilization and cash assistance with rent, utilities, and security deposits to households citywide to resolve a housing crisis and prevent homelessness. Homeless Centralized Intake Services sites:

- The Red Shield after-hours reception for families 715
 N Broad Street after 3 pm
- Station House after-hours reception 2601 N. Broad
 Street after 3 pm
- Ridge Center intake and after-hours reception for single males 1360 Ridge Avenue.
