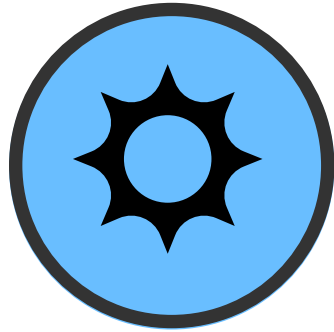


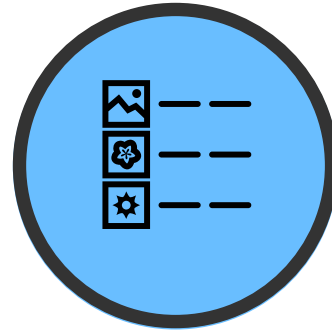
# ✓ Post-Lecture Processing

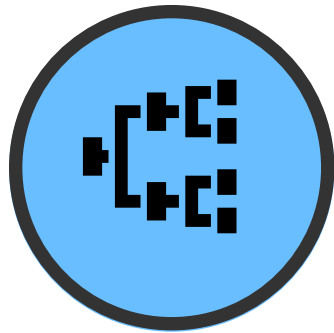
## Same Day

This pass through the material should happen the same day as lecture, or maybe the day after, to minimize forgetting and aid comprehension.



## Summary

Focus on summary and synthesis that reflects your understanding at this stage. Don't attempt to write a detailed study guide or outline.



## Organization

Focus on how the information may be organized - either according to syllabus, text, slides, learning objectives, or your own sense of the material.



## Resources

Identify where to find the information you will need to study for each section of the topic. Note how you plan to use text, slides, images, or other materials. Flag key resources, but don't copy a lot of information.



## Questions

Identify questions you have or gaps in your understanding. Identify information or key areas you know you will need to study.



## Plans for Study

Plan best ways to work with the material - drawings, tables, charts, flashcards, learning objectives, case histories, or questions to use for self-testing.
