Thomas Jefferson University's ("TJU") Anti-Hazing Report (the "Report") is published in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Timothy J. Piazza Anti-Hazing Law, 18 Pa.C.S. § 2801 *et seq.* The following Report contains information that has been reported to TJU over the prior five consecutive years or from years 2014 through 2019 to the extent TJU has retained such information.

II. Information Regarding Hazing Incidents

TJU's annual Report on hazing contains information for each substantiated report of hazing received by TU over the preceding five years. Specifically, to the extent such information is available, the Report includes for each such incident: (1) the name of the subject of the hazing report; (2) the date the subject was charged with a hazing violation; (3) a general description of the violation, any investigation and findings by the institution, and any penalties; and (4) the date of resolution.

TJU has had no reports of hazing over the last five years or from 2014 through 2019. Accordingly, TJU has no information to report for the referenced timeframe.
