# Using Panopto in Canvas: *A How-To Guide for Faculty*

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As you get started with Canvas, utilize this guide to help you make the most of using Panopto within Canvas. With Panopto you can easily create, host, search, and share videos with your courses.

#### **Enabling Panopto in a Canvas Course**

Log in to Canvas and access your course.
