You need not complete all prerequisites before you apply, however, the majority should be completed before an admissions decision can be made. For the science prerequisites (A&P I and II), we highly prefer at least Anatomy and Physiology I with Lab to be completed at time of initial application submission. All prerequisites must be completed, at a regionally accredited institution, before you enter the program.

\*\*If a student's institution does not offer Cultural Anthropology, a course that covers multiple cultures and/or ethnicities from a broad perspective based in anthropology or the social sciences will be accepted. We encourage students to contact the Admissions Office to confirm their course will meet the prerequisite requirement.

Course Clarification: All science courses (A&P I and II w/ Lab and Physics w/Lab) must be completed within 10 years of application to Jefferson. Courses can be completed in an on-campus or online format. Courses must be completed with a grade of "B-" or above to meet the prerequisite requirement. A grade of "C+" or below will not meet the prerequisite requirement. You may also earn credits through standardized tests, such as AP & CLEP, pending department approval. Credits are calculated on a semester scale; if courses are taken on a quarter scale, the credit hours will be converted to the semester credit scale.

**Technical Standards:** In addition to meeting all academic requirements, students must meet all performance requirements for the program.
