Admissions Tips

- Applications are reviewed as they are completed
- Application deadlines:
 - Priority deadline: March 1st
 - Final deadline: August 1st
- Check your MyJefferson account to monitor the status of your application

- Cost per credit is \$1,200 plus fees (2021-22)
- Applicants are automatically considered for any available scholarships
- We recommend checking with your employer to see if any tuition benefits may be applied to this program
- This program is not eligible for federal financial aid
