

- **New Student Orientation**
 - Summer Orientation
 - Welcome Week
- **First Year Seminar**
 - Weekly one hour class for first year students with an Instructor and upper division student Peer Mentor
 - Tips and tricks to survive the first semester
 - Co-curricular experiences
- **First Year Experience**
 - 30 trips and activities in Philadelphia just for first year students
 - Free or greatly discounted
 - Includes transportation
- **Alpha Lambda Delta Honor Society**
 - National honor society for first year and transfer students who are in the top 20% of their class at the end of their first year on campus
 - Lifetime membership upon induction including scholarship opportunities and career placement benefits



Emerging Leaders Program

- Geared toward first and second year students
- Focus on individual leadership skills
- Small cohort model (10 students with Instructor and Peer Mentor)
- Occurs in the spring semester

LEAD Retreat

- Geared toward upper division students with leadership experience
- Focus on group dynamics and community building
- Three day/two night retreat off campus

LINC Program

- Program to honor leadership experiences across ten milestones
- Prove experiences with artifacts and written overviews
- Upon completion you obtain a notation on your transcript, a medallion to wear at graduation, and a letter of recommendation from the Dean of Students
