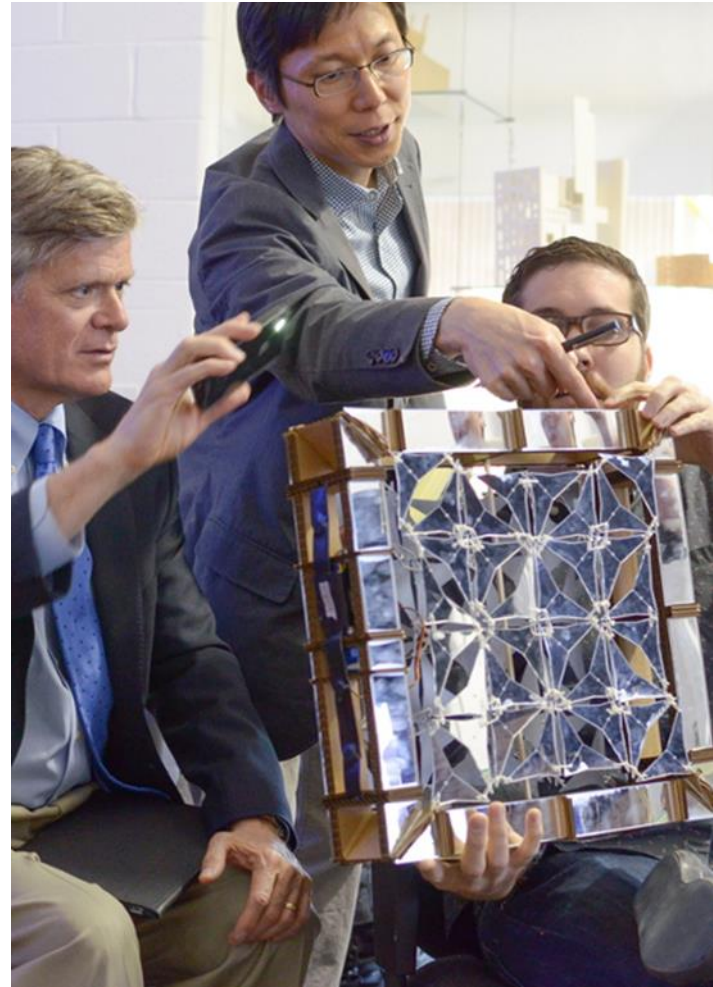
- Green campus in East Falls, close to Center City and many amazing communities

- Application
 - Jefferson Application: my.Jefferson.edu/apply or
 - Common Application
- Official college transcripts from EVERY college or university attended
 - If you have completed fewer than 30 college credits or have not completed college algebra or a higher math, please send your final high school transcript and SAT or ACT scores for review
- One letter of recommendation
- Essay

Application Requirements: Portfolio

- Required for **Architecture** and **Landscape Architecture** transfer applicants who have previously taken design courses
- Optional for all other applicants to the College of Architecture and the Built Environment

Application Requirements: International Students

In addition to the application materials listed, international applicants should submit:

- A course-by-course evaluation from a NACES-approved academic credential evaluation service. www.naces.org
- Proof of English proficiency
 - TOEFL
 - IELTS
 - Duolingo
 - English Composition I and II (grade of C) from a U.S. university

 - December 1, 2020
- Application deadline for Fall 2021 students
 - June 1, 2021
