

- One letter of recommendation
- Essay

- Required for all transfer applicants to the Fashion Design program
- Optional for all other applicants to the School of Design and Engineering



## Application Requirements: International Students

In addition to the application materials listed, international applicants should submit:

- A course-by-course evaluation from a NACES-approved academic credential evaluation service. www.naces.org
- Proof of English proficiency
  - TOEFL
  - IELTS
  - Duolingo
  - English Composition I and II (minimum grade of C) from a U.S. university
  - Educational Services (ELS), completion of Level 112
  - Bridge English, Level 5
