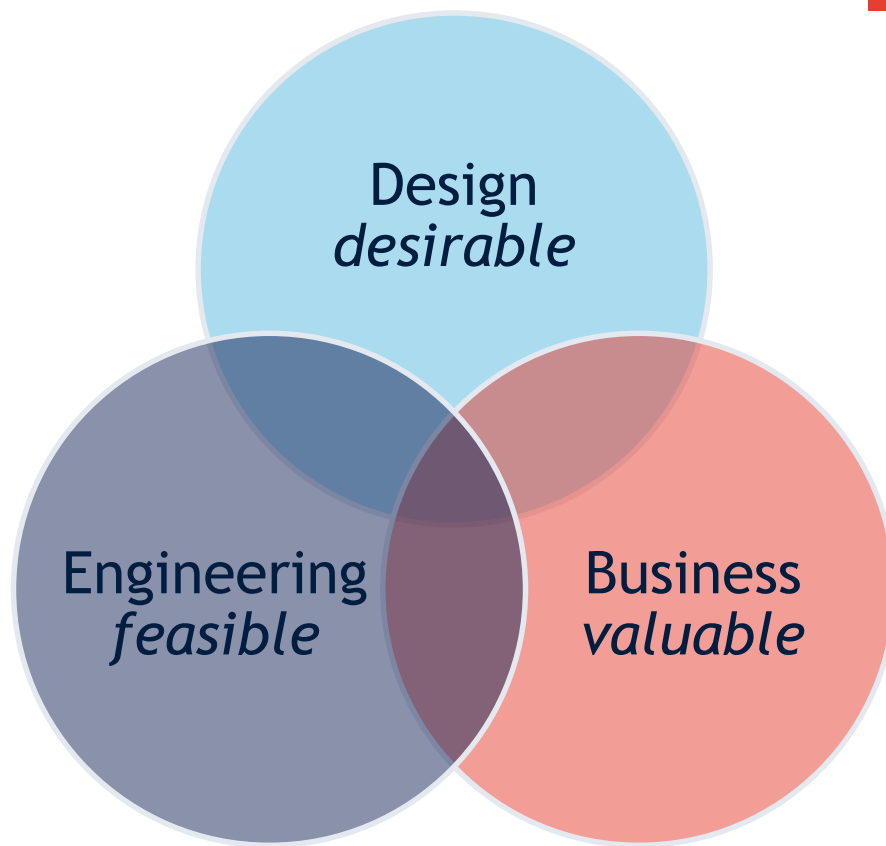

- Official college transcripts from EVERY college or university attended
  - If you have completed fewer than 30 college credits or have not completed college algebra or a higher math, please send your final high school transcript and SAT or ACT scores for review
- One letter of recommendation
- Essay

# Application Requirements: Portfolio

- Required for all transfer applicants to the **Fashion Design** program
- Optional for all other applicants to the School of Design and Engineering



# Application Requirements: International Students

In addition to the application materials listed, international applicants should submit:

- A course-by-course evaluation from a NACES-approved academic credential evaluation service. [www.naces.org](http://www.naces.org)
- Proof of English proficiency
  - TOEFL
  - IELTS
  - Duolingo
  - English Composition I and II (minimum grade of C) from a U.S. university
  - Educational Services (ELS), completion of Level 112
  - Bridge English, Level 5

- Application deadline for Fall 2021 students
  - June 1, 2021
