# FOOD SERVICE





# ORIENTATION




## REGISTRATION

## DORM COUNCIL GETS VISITING HOURS EXTENDED





Living in a dormitory is a different type of existence. It combines the worst aspects of living in a hotel and an army barracks. The Dorm Council was designed to help the dorm student cope with his living facilities. It is a mediator between the students and the Dean of Students. It helps to set up the rules that the dorm is governed by and sponsors entertainment for the dorm students. Its big accomplishment this year has been to get visitation hours reestablished and lengthened. These include week-night visitation hours for women in the men's dorm.



## IS TEXTILE COED?

Yes, there are women at Textile and some of them even live on campus. Actually living at school for a coed means that she lives in an apartment about a mile away from school. She is responsible for doing her own cooking and a lot of the cleaning. She must also adjust to living with several other girls in an area that may be lacking a bed only in the kitchen. As is, one of the worst things is the failure of the school to maintain the apartments correctly.





## Why do we need more black students?

We need more black students because, with the vast social changes that have taken place in the United States in recent years, education in a virtually all-white institution can no longer be considered a good education. And our students deserve a good education.

The relationships between the races and all of their ramifications form the most pressing domestic issue facing Americans. And it's no longer enough for well-educated Americans to view this issue telescopically. White college students must have the opportunity to get to know black college students through normal classroom and campus activities.

No American educational institution can say that it is doing its job today unless it is providing the opportunity for blacks and whites to come together routinely, to overcome their fears of one another and to learn to understand and trust one another.

It is the function of education to combat ignorance, and the fears that are bred by ignorance. It is the function of education to broaden experience. It is the function of education to expand awareness of the potential of being human.

The purpose of this college is education. And education cannot be defined by classrooms and textbooks. It is much more comprehensive than this. A total college experience means interacting with different kinds of people and thereby becoming aware of our own narrowness of background and outlook and at the same time of our potential to grow out of this narrowness.







Next year's squad will be built around mainstep Sammy Corr and Mike Rapp, both top runners and scorers for the 1969 team. Lew Jacobson and Danny McCreight helped round out the squad. It is understood that a number of high school runners have enrolled at Textile. It is with optimism that plans are being made to build up our Cross-Country team.




## TENNIS TEAM SECOND IN M.A.C. CONFERENCE





# ENGINEERING CLUB VISITS SOUTH CAROLINA








## PHI PSI GOES TO NORTH CAROLINA




## PHOTOGRAPHY CLUB







## RESEARCH IN CHEMISTRY


