The Future Health Professionals Program is a 16-week educational and experiential program for underrepresented minority high school sophomores, juniors and seniors interested in careers in the health professions. Students attend sessions for two hours per week (4:00 pm – 6:00 pm). The program begins in October and ends in March. Students who complete the program and meet the program requirements are awarded a Certificate of Participation.

Through interaction with faculty and students, participants have the opportunity to explore careers in medicine, nursing, the health professions (couple and family therapy, medical laboratory sciences & biotechnology, occupational therapy, physician assistant studies, physical therapy, radiologic sciences), pharmacy, population health, and the biomedical sciences. These sessions are designed to prepare participants for future health care careers.
